- 3. How have you experienced these things in your own life and relationship with God? Can you identify with what Paul is writing about in v13-19?
- 4. While Christ is the catalyst for reconciliation, the church is God's chosen vehicle for it. In what ways should the church express and example reconciliation to the world?
- 5. What would it look like for you to participate in what Jesus is doing in the church (v20-22)?
- 6. Paul was called to the Gentiles. To whom do you feel called to reach and share the love of Jesus with?
